# LANDFILL INFORMATION

#### Address/Hours:

39144 W. Sutton Creek Rd., Baker City, OR Monday-Saturday 9am-4pm -Minimum charge at the landfill is \$20.00 for up to 668 lbs. All other garbage will be prorated at \$59.85/ton. Cash, card, or check accepted. -Yard Debris is FREE at the landfill for residence. Please haul your grass, weeds, leaves, brush, and limbs in a separate load. -No sod, rock, dirt, or stumps/logs larger than 12 inches in diameter.

Provided below is information to help you make the best use of you trash collection. With your help, we can provide you and your family the best service possible for the least cost.

# **GARBAGE COLLECTION**

2. We provide curbside service- please have your cart out by 5am. (3am for rural routes)

3. Carts must sit with handles facing away from the curb.

4. We need 4 feet of clearance around your cart. Please insure no vehicles are blocking access and multiple carts are spaced apart.

5. Garbage must not extend outside your cart. If the lid is open more than 10", there could be an extra charge. Bagged, boxed, or bundled material within 1 foot of the cart will be considered trash and picked up for an extra charge.

6. The cart cannot weigh more than 200lbs.

7. Ashes should be soaked in water and bagged before being placed in the cart.

Bins Available 24/7 at Baker Sanitary Service

Aluminum Cans/Foll -Non-magnetic, just rinse

#### **Corrugated Cardboard**

-Flattened -NO waxed or plastic lined boxes

#### Glass Bottles/Jars

-Any color ok, just rinse -NO dishes, vases, light bulbs, mirrors, windows, etc.

#### Magazines/Catalogs/Newspapers

-Throw in loose, NO bags or twine, NO books

#### HDPE Natural (translucent)

- -Plastic milk jugs, water jugs, etc.
- Toss lids and rinse well
- -NO other plastics

#### **Tinned/Steel Cans**

-Magnetic, rinse and remove labels

#### Bins Available M-F 8AM-4PM, See office for locations

#### Botteries, CFL bulbs, Fluorescent lights

Please tape small, flat batteries on both sides
 These items can be brought to the office for
recycling.

#### E-Waste (Electronic Waste)

-Computer monitors, computer towers, keyboards, mice, printers, and televisions.

#### Metal

 Small mixed metal items can be placed in bin at Baker Sanitary Service, large or heavy can be taken to the landfill

#### Motor Oil

-Please place in original or clear gallon container. Place in oil collection station.

#### HDPE Colored Bottles

-Laundry detergent, shampoo, etc. -Toss lids and rinse well, no other plastic -All colors including clear and white

-White or pastel office paper -Please dump out of plastic bags or baxes

#### First Wednesday of Every Month, Call Office for appointment

#### Household Hazardous Waste

-Flammable liquids, corrosives, chemicals, pesticides - even fluorescent tubes, PCB ballasts, batteries, non-recyclable paint or spray paint."

 The only wastes which can't be accepted are radioactive materials, explosives, certain very reactive materials, and "acutely hazardous wastes."

HHW is free for individuals. Businesses will have to fill out a CEG packet prior to appointment which can be found at bakersanitary.com "Liquid recyclable paint should be take to Thatcher's Ace Hardware or Miller's Lumber to be recycled. Please call with any questions.
